Who is Charlie G. Brooks, Jr.?

Charlie Brooks has been a Tennessee respiratory therapist for over 25 years. He has been an instructor, department manager and a president of the AARC. This scholarship acknowledges his participation and dedication in and to the respiratory care community.

Who is eligible for the scholarship?

Any respiratory therapist desiring to continue his/her education and is currently licensed as a respiratory care practitioner (certified or registered) in Tennessee.

What are the scholarship criteria?

Be an AARC member. A photocopy of your AARC membership card or a statement of membership from the AARC must be submitted.

1. Be a licensed respiratory care practitioner in Tennessee. A photocopy of your current license must be submitted.
2. Officially accepted into a program of study that will advance the individuals standing in the profession including but not limited to:
3. Be currently working in the field of Respiratory Care. Officially accepted into a program of study that will advance the individuals standing in the profession including but not limited to:
 - a) A CRT enrolled in an RRT program.
 - b) An RRT enrolled in a BS program.
 - c) Pursuing an advanced degree (bachelors, masters or doctorate).
4. Provide one letter of professional reference.
5. Provide one letter of recommendation from a faculty member or advisor of the program the individual is enrolled in.
6. Provide one letter of recommendation from a faculty member or advisor of the program the individual is enrolled in.
 - a) The faculty member/advisor must indicate the student is in good standing and has at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
7. Email a document describing how the advanced degree fits into his/her career plans as a respiratory care practitioner to mhadley7175@gmail.com
 - a) Verification of receipt will routinely be sent within 48 hours.
 - b) Those who do not receive such verification should call for verification.

Applications will not be considered unless ALL the requested information is provided and accompanied by all of the requested supporting documents. **ALL MATERIALS MUST BE RECEIVED BY 5:00 pm, CST, March 27, 2019 and must include:**

Name and full address
School and course of study/degree
Date started program and date of graduation
Attestation to all information provided
